Hearts With A Mission's Independent Living Program (ILP) assists youth age 14-23 who are, or were in foster care (for at least 180 days, after the age of 13) to take the next steps in their lives to gain life skills and become independent adults.

The program teaches youth valuable skills to make a successful transition from foster care to independent living.

The program offers a variety of learning opportunities, including: skills groups, and one-on-one supports, access to financial support (through ILP discretionary funds), Independent Living Housing Subsidy Program, and education/grant support.

All services are individually tailored to the needs of the specific youth.
